

ENCAMPMENT PERSONAL CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

A. REQUIRED MALE SERVICE UNIFORM

- 1 Pr. Blue service trousers
- 2 Ea. Blue Short sleeve shirt w/insignia & ribbons
- 1 Ea. Blue Belt (web or elastic) with silver buckle
- 7 Pr. Black socks
- 1 Pr. Shoes, Black Oxfords plain toe
- 1 Ea. Flight Cap w/ insignia
- 3 Ea. White V-neck T-shirts

B. REQUIRED FEMALE SERVICE UNIFORM

- 1 Pr. Blue service slacks or blue service skirt
- 2 Ea. Blue Short sleeve blouse w/insignia & ribbons
- 1 Ea. Blue Belt (web or elastic) with silver buckle
- 3 Pr. Pantyhose, nylon neutral shade, black, off-black, or dark brown without pattern or black socks if wearing slacks
- 1 Pr. Shoes, Black loafer or Oxfords plain toe
- 1 Ea. Flight Cap w/ insignia
- 3 Ea. White V-neck T-shirts

C. REQUIRED UTILITY UNIFORM

- 2 Sets **Woodland BDU or ABU** w/insignia
- 1 Ea. **Woodland BDU or ABU** patrol cap
- 5 Ea. Black (BDU)/Sand (ABU) crew neck T-shirts
- 1 Ea. Black or blue web belt with black buckle
- 1 Pr. Combat, jump or jungle boots

D. REQUIRED ATHLETIC UNIFORM

- 1 Pr. Athletic shoes
- 7 Pr. White athletic socks
- 1 Pr. Sweat pants, grey
- 1 Pr. Athletic shorts, **black**

E. REQUIRED PERSONAL ITEMS

- 7 Pr. Underclothing
- 1 Pr. Sleeping Clothes/Pajamas
- 1 Ea. Raincoat/Poncho
- 3 Ea. Towels and washcloths
- 1 Ea. Soap and Shampoo
- 1 Ea. Toothbrush and toothpaste

CONTRABAND ITEMS

Belongings will be inspected for contraband. Contraband will be confiscated. Disposable items such as food will not be returned. **Possession of firearms, alcohol, illegal drugs (including prescription drugs without a prescription), and tobacco products could result in a member's dismissal from encampment. Illegal items will be turned over to authorities for further action.**

- Weapons (including knives of any kind and weapon replicas)
- Drugs (unless prescribed by a doctor)
- Cigarettes and tobacco products
- Fireworks and ignition sources (matches, lighters, etc.)
- Personal electronic devices (iPods, mp3 players, etc.)
- Video games & gaming systems

REQUIRED PERSONAL ITEMS (cont.)

- 1 Ea. Personal grooming kit
- 1 Ea. Shaving kit (males)
- 1 Ea. Cosmetic kit (females)
- 1 Ea. Shoe shine kit
- 1 Ea. Flashlight and batteries
- 1 Ea. Canteen w/belt and holder or Camelbak style hydration system (must be black, brown, olive drab green, tan, camouflage, or other conservative colors)
- 2 Ea. Black pens
- 1 Ea. Notebook (3"x5" recommended)

F. SUGGESTED ITEMS

- 1 Ea. Field Jacket (with all proper insignia) or Gortex Parka (w/blue tab insignia – Vanguard item #CAP1010)
- 1 Pr. Shower clogs
- 1 Ea. Camera (no smartphones, iPod, etc...)
- 1 Ea. 12" ruler
- 1 Ea. Lint brush
- 1 Ea. Robe
- 1 Ea. Spare flashlight batteries and bulb
- 1 Pr. Spare combat boots
- 1 Ea. Sewing kit
- Spare uniform items, patches and insignia
- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen

G. **WCA ONLY** - ADDITIONAL REQUIRED ITEMS

- 2pr. Blue service trousers (total of 2; males only)
- 2pr. Blue service slacks or blue service skirt (females only)
- 2 pens (black) and 2 pencils
- 1 ea. Standard sized notebook
- 1ea. Blue service tie and tie tack/bar (males only)
- 1ea. Tie tab (females only)
- 7ea. White V-neck T-shirts (total of 7; both males and females)

H. **WCA ONLY** - ADDITIONAL SUGGESTED ITEMS

- 1ea. Lightweight blue (poplin) jacket
- 1ea. Iron and starch
- 1ea. Laundry detergent
- 1ea. Wristwatch

- Playing cards
- Novels, magazines, reading material
- Food (candy, snacks, etc.) & Drink
- Items of clothing with inappropriate slogans or artwork
- Immodest clothing
- Mobile phones

NOTES

- Bring all items, there will not be a chance to purchase items at encampment.
- Cadets may bring limited spending money (\$40 suggested)
- Cameras must be stand-alone devices. Staff will confiscate all electronics, except cameras, during in-processing.
- Remove all photos from a camera's memory card prior to arrival. Memory cards will be erased at the start of encampment.
- If you need uniform items check with your squadron. **It is your responsibility to ensure you have all items on the packing list and that those items meet uniform regulations (CAPM 39-1) upon your arrival.**
- **Ensure your haircut meets regulation before you arrive. Cadets with a non-regulation haircut will be required to get a haircut in Tomah or Mauston prior to being accepted into encampment, or will be required to get a haircut during encampment from a licensed provider at the member's expense.**
